- Child / Youth PHOTOGRAPHER to produce a digital image.
- Child / Youth 3D SCULPTOR please send /email photographs for the first round of judging.
- Child / Youth **DIGITAL ART** design a digital piece on a computer or tablet.
- Child / Youth PERFORMING ARTS email (or cloud link) a short, recorded, 2 minute original piece.

Each category will be judged by a panel of professional artists who have a knowledge of each subject.

RULES OF ENTRY

- 1. ALL entrants for the competition must have a **DISABILITY** of some kind.
- 2. A person may only submit one entry in each category. All entries must be on the themes specified, A BETTER WORLD, NATURE or 'SCAPES' (land, sea etc) and other themes will be excluded from the competition by the head judge.
- 3. Each entrant will need to fill out the application form for the category he or she would like to enter. This can be downloaded from our web site.
- 4. A parent, guardian or school teacher MUST sign the application form.
- 5. All entrants must download, complete and email back an entry form with ALL sections filled in. The emailed COMPLETED FORM and the IMAGE jpg. must have the entrant's **NAME** for reference. Any JPG images or entry forms that are sent without the entrant's name will not be included.

PRIZES

2nd Place - £400 in vouchers and £2,000 for their school.
3rd Place - £200 in vouchers and £1,000 for their school.

Art Teacher Award - £2,000 in vouchers, or equivalent for other department winners.

All finalists will be invited to a presentation ceremony in the Autumn of 2022 where the top three overall winners will receive their prizes.
