THERE ARE FIVE THEMES TO CHOOSE FROM FOR 2021:

Corona, My Happy Place, Community, How The World Sees Me and Plastic.

There are 3 categories. CHILD 7-15, YOUTH 16 - 21 and GROUP WORK

- Child / Youth PAINTER to produce a digital image of your artwork.
- Child / Youth PHOTOGRAPHER to produce a digital image.
- Child / Youth 3D SCULPTOR please send /email photographs for the first round of judging.
- Child / Youth **DIGITAL ART** design a digital piece on a computer or tablet.
- Child / Youth PERFORMING ARTS to produce a 2 minute original piece recorded and sent by post.

Each category will be judged by a panel of professional artists who have a knowledge of each subject.

RULES OF ENTRY

- 1. ALL entrants for the competition must have a **DISABILITY** of some kind.
- 2. A person may only submit one entry in each category. All entries must be on the themes specified above and other themes will be <u>excluded</u> from the competition by the head judge.
- 3. Each entrant will need to fill out the application form for the category he or she would like to enter. This can be downloaded from our web site.
- 4. A parent, guardian or school teacher MUST sign the application form.
- 5. All entrants must download, complete and email back an entry form with ALL sections filled in. The emailed COMPLETED FORM and the IMAGE jpg. must **BOTH** have the entrant's **NAME** for reference.

 Any entries that are sent without the entrant's name will not be included in the competition.
- 7. Submissions must be received between Monday 11th January and 30th April 2021.

ARTS TEACHER IN SPECIAL EDUCATION AWARD

We would also like to recognise the work done by teachers in the arts in special education and would like to offer an award to highlight excellence in this field which includes Art, Drama and Music. We would ask Schools and Colleges to enter this category by sending a written paper outlining why the nominated teacher deserves the award and how he or she goes 'above and beyond' their normal teaching duties. PRIZES

There will be three finalists from each age group in each of the five categories - Bronze (3rd) Silver (2nd) and Gold (1st).

Each finalist will receive a certificate and a £50 Great Art Voucher, or category related equivalent.

The prizes for the top three winners overall are:

1st Place - £600 in vouchers and £3,000 for their school.
2nd Place - £400 in vouchers and £2,000 for their school.
3rd Place - £200 in vouchers and £1,000 for their school.

Art Teacher Award - £2,000 in vouchers, or equivalent for other department winners.

All finalists will be invited to a presentation ceremony in October 2021 where the top three overall winners will receive their prizes.
